Wohlsen Construction Company received four awards from the Delaware Chapter of Associated Builders and Contractors (ABC) at the association's recent Excellence in Construction Awards Gala.

The Beebe Medical Center Overbuild Addition and Renovation project received a First Place Award of Excellence. The award was received in the GC/CM Over \$30 million category. The project included 70,360 square feet of overbuild and renovations to the emergency department, critical care unit, medical / surgical unit and construction of a rooftop helipad.



An Award of Excellence in the GC/CM \$5 – 10 million category was received for the Hockessin Library constructed in New Castle County. The project included a 7,846 sq. ft. addition and 14,616 sq. ft. of renovations to create a inviting place for adults and children to read and do research.

The Nemours Mansion and Garden restoration received an Award of Merit in the GC/CM \$20 - \$30 million category. The scope of the project included 47,000 square feet of historic restorations and renovations the historic Nemours Mansion constructed in 1910 by Alfred I. DuPont.



An award of merit in the GC/CM \$5 – 10 million category was also received for construction of the new Nemours Visitors Center located on the grounds of the historic Nemours Mansion
