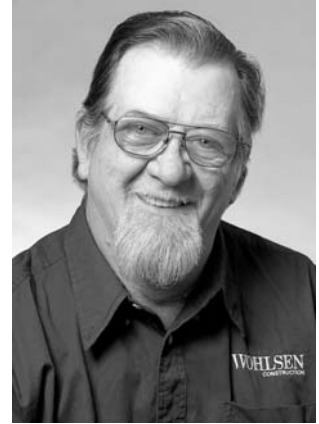

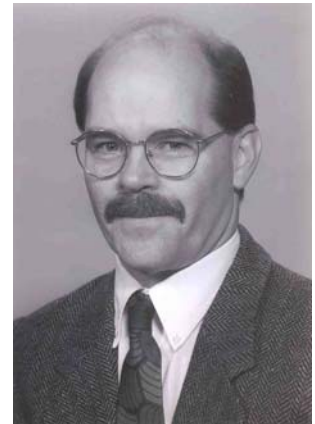
WOHLSSEN PRESENTS ANNUAL AWARDS
